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SERVICES AND WHAT TO EXPECT

All children in my care will receive constant supervision, food, drinks, snacks, and proper hygiene practices. If you prefer to supply food items please feel free. They will be cared for like family. They will have access to indoor and outdoor activities of your choosing, when they are available. Our home will be heated and cooled to a comfortable temperature. See activities and food section for more details.

For full time and part time care

Ages 24-36 months

We will work on ABC's, Numbers, Vocabulary, Speech, Reading, Flash cards, Colors, Shapes, Drawing, Coloring, Puzzles, Building Blocks, Basic Painting, Crafts, Potty training, Dancing, Jumping, Hand Washing, Manners, Sharing, Music, and Picking Up Toys.

Ages 3 to 6

We will learn everything from 24-36 months and continue into more Reading, Writing, Basic Math, Comprehension, Basic Research, Music, Painting, Color mixing, Baking, and Projects.

For Before and After School Care

They will be offered snacks and drinks. We will then work on homework. When all homework is done they will be allowed to play, watch cartoons, movies, play Minecraft, the Wii, or Disney Infinity. On good weather days they will be urged to go outside.

Summer time care for older school age children.

We will work on skills for the next grade level. They will be assigned one skill building project each morning. They will also have full access to food, drinks, and snacks. They will be urged to go outside on every good weather day. They will also be asked to help with simple tasks. At the end of the day they will be allowed to watch cartoons, movies, play Minecraft, the Wii, or Disney Infinity.

For Date Nights

They will have snacks and drinks. They will be allowed to play, watch cartoons, movies, play Minecraft, the Wii, or Disney Infinity. On good weather days they will be urged to go outside.

For Daily and Hourly Care

Your child will be supervised and entertained. They will have access to indoor and outdoor activities. They will be educated through play and reading. They will be supplied food and drinks.

DISCIPLINE AND REWARDS SYSTEM

My promise to you is to encourage a healthy, safe, group environment. Children will learn sharing, working together, manners and respect for others.

DISCIPLINE

I will use keywords, raising my voice, conversation, consistency, redirection, and change of environment to control upset children. In all cases there will be no physical or mental punishment from myself or others.

All Children get upset. My goal is to engage why they are upset and find a solution. If a child seems irritable, it is usually because they are hungry, tired, or over stimulated. In this situation I will offer them a snack, down time, or a nap. In situations where they are upset over a toy, then I will encourage sharing or redirection to something else. If a toy becomes a major issue, it will be removed from site for the rest of the week.

When a child is upset I will be looking out for the safety of all the children. If a child seems out of control and hurting themselves or others, I will have to remove them from the group until they calm down. In a case where they are still upset after 30 minutes, I will inform the parent for intervention. If a child displays aggression for more than two days they will be sent home. In a case where it continues daily they will be removed from my care.

REWARDS

Children will be rewarded for good behavior by praise. At the end of the day they may be given a sticker for good behavior. If a good behavior chart is needed it will be implemented. On some occasions they may be given permission to select from a treasure chest.

FOOD POLICIES

Sanitation is a priority

As a former Manager of a Schlotzkys Deli I understand the importance of proper food preparation and sanitation. I will be eating what your children eat, so you can expect that it will be prepared to high expectations. All counters and utensils in use will be cleaned and sterilized before food preparation begins. All utensils, plates, bowls, and cups will be cleaned and sterilized before your child uses them. Hands will be washed prior to food preparation and frequently throughout the cooking process. At no time will I contaminate the food with dirty utensils. Food that falls on a dirty surface will be thrown away.

Food Allergies

We are a Gluten free family. If you are not familiar with this term, it means we do not eat any wheat, rye, or Barley. We use rice, tapioca, quinoa, corn, and Udis breads. If you are not comfortable with this diet for your child please provide food and snacks. We eat a bounty of Meats, Fish, Fruit, Vegetables, nuts and rice. If your child has a Food Allergy or intolerance, I will be more than qualified to provided that diet for your child. If you are vegetarian, please provide recipes so I may cook for your child. Or you may supply your child's meals. Being a Celiac I will prepare all foods in a manner to prevent contamination. I understand the importance and risks of cross contamination of allergen foods.

Please provide your child's food allergies including, but not limited to fruits, vegetables, meats, fish, nuts, grains, sauces, spices, dairy and juices.

I am a fairly good cook. I will also cater to your child's likes and dislikes.

If you would like me to feed your child please understand that I will be providing industry grade sanitation and preparation. If you decide to provide all food and snacks for your child, please fill out the allergen section only and sign below. MENU

All Menu items are gluten free and prepared in a gluten free environment. Items will depend on weekly preparation. I will cook Sunday for M-W and Wednesday for T-F. On occasion it will be supplemented with a pre-made frozen meal. A balanced diet of proteins, dairy, whole grains, fats, fresh/frozen fruit and vegetables will be provided. All food will be cut appropriately for your child's age and eating abilities. For any food allergies please provide them on page 5 of this contract.

Water will be filtered RainSoft, bottled Ozarka or Distilled.
Water will be available all day or offered every hour. Milk will be offered in the mornings only. On special occasions they may have a second juice or milk in the afternoon.

Milk, orange juice, and water will be available.

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES AND SICK CHILDREN

In case of a fire or other emergency, I will transport your children to safety. My designated location will be Lakeline mall, or another location that I specify to you by phone.

In a medial emergency such as an injury, sickness, or other life threatening situation my first response will be to address the situation. My second procedure will be to do what I can, then I will transport your child to emergency room or call an ambulance. I will notify you as soon as I am able, or after your child is being medically cared for.

SICK CHILDREN

I am ok with watching sick children who have seen a Doctor, fevers are responding to Tylenol, are not throwing up, do not have uncontrolled bowel movements and are not infected with a serious illness such as chickenpox, measles or any other viral disease. Other children's parents will also have to be ok that your child is in my care. At any time your child seems worse you will be notified to pick them up. For illnesses that spread through groups all children are likely to catch it. Proper sanitation and cleaning doesn't always prevent the spread of illnesses. As long as I am well and able I will continue to provide care. On sick Days children will spend most of their time in down time. They will be feed and given baths or showers to help control fevers or mucus. Toys, blankets, bedding, bathrooms, door handles, and counters will be sanitized daily or hourly during this time. Please make sure your child receives all recommended shots. Yearly flu shots are recommended. Airborne multivitamins help to keep children healthy especially in winter months.

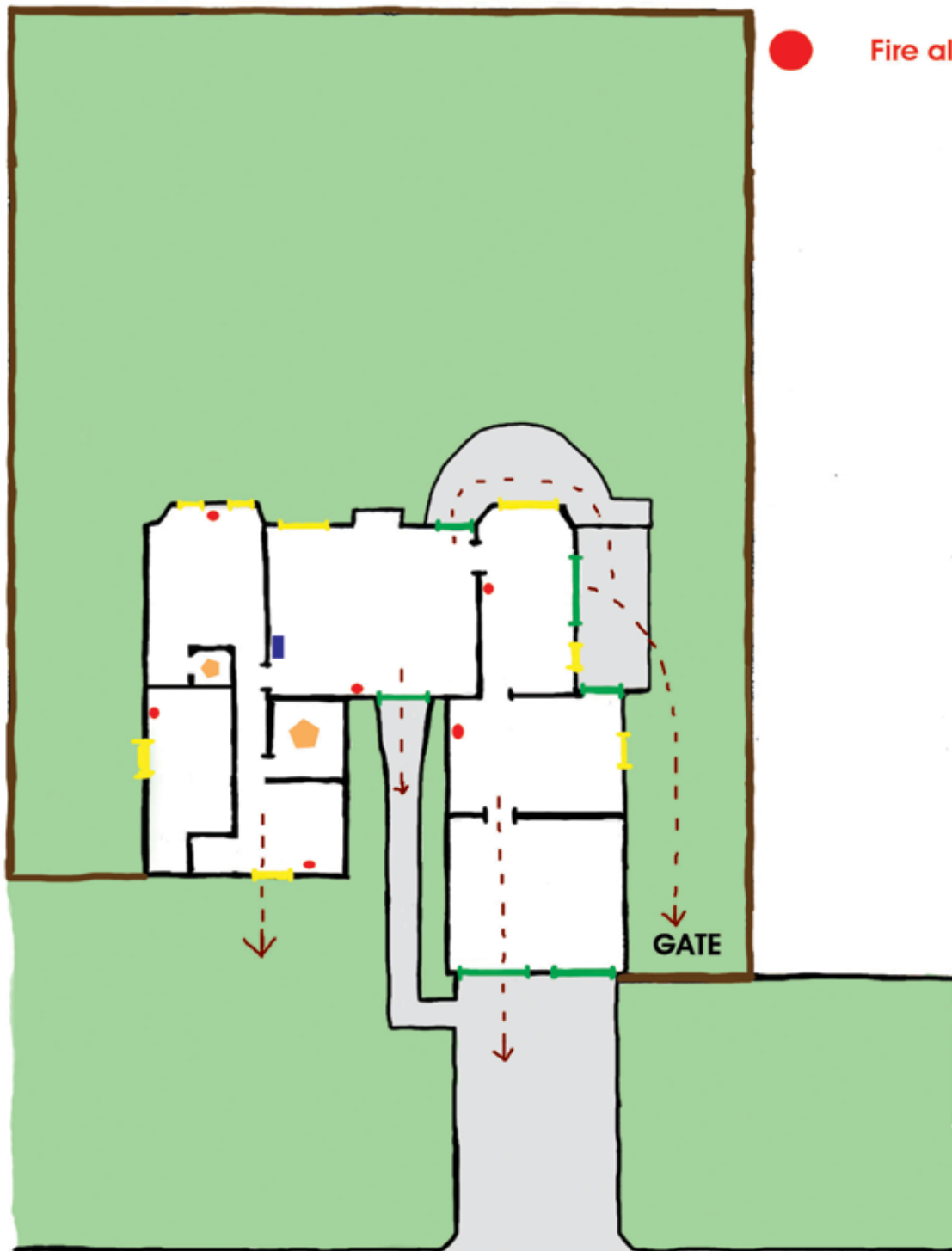

Nap time is allowed at any time for your children. Snacks will be offered between meals or if children show signs of hunger. Water will be offered and available always. Indoor activities include working on Age group learning. We will do weekly art projects or crafts. For school age Children they will be free for the last half of the day to do as they wish if their homework or assignments are done. The last hour of my care they can have electronic time. See the Activities on page 12 for full list of entertainment.

CLEANING SCHEDULE

Daily:

Every morning I will pick up toys or clutter.

I will sweep all floors, do the dishes, wipe counters, chairs, tables and mop as needed.

We will Clean up after our pets

Weekly:

I will clean bathrooms, showers, blankets, bedding and laundry. Mopping and dusting will be done as needed. We will clean the yard and pick up after our pets.

I will be calling a certified maid service if I cannot keep up with the cleaning.

We will sanitize and clean toys or when a child becomes ill.

The yard will be mowed and picked up. We will do a heavy cleaning of the floors and dusting.

My son is good about playing in a well behaved manor. He also tells me when something is not right.

During any outside activities all children will be present and supervised. During water activities they will be watched extremely close and will have age appropriate water levels. They will not be left unsupervised at any time for any reason. Small children will be with me at all times older children will be allowed to run around the yard in different areas. Older children will be constantly reminded to watch out for younger children. For transport, field trips, bouncy house, or park visits I will ask for permission prior to use.

If you have any concerns for an activity, or your child's safety please speak with me freely. My goal is to allow them to be educated and play in a safe environment. I will strive to remove dangers and keep things out of reach that may be harmful to any children including my own. If a child does not play correctly with any activities listed above, the activity will become unavailable until I feel they are mature enough to safely engage in that activity.

This is a sustained home grown eco system. It is a garden and tilapia farm. We maintain it naturally without the use of chemicals or additives. We use city water or rain water when needed. We naturally provided Minerals and vitamins. The fish are feed floating catfish food purchased from the feed store.

It is a new age idea and a great learning experience for all children of any age. In winter months it is enclosed in a green house.
We will provide constant supervision for all children around the system.

How it works: The fish eat and fertilize the water. The pump delivers water and fertilizer to the plants. There are red worms in the grow beds that help break down nutrients. The plants filter the water and return it to the fish. It is a really neat way to garden. The plants and fish both benefit from it, so does our wildlife.

Older children will be advised to play nicely with her while being supervised. She will stay outside for most of the day and let in the dining area in the afternoons. She will not be around any children that are uncomfortable with pets. I will take every precaution to keep all children and pet's safe at all times. She is a fantastic dog for teaching children to train and interact with pets.

As a caregiver I will take every precaution to ensure your child's safety with my pets and while they are napping. Please understand that I cannot be held liable for deaths or injuries unless upon investigation, evidence is provided that the death or injury was intentionally caused by me or other another family member. I will only be keeping up to three children that are not my own. I can watch no more than six including my own. My daughter is 3 and my son is school age of 8. He is currently attending first grade at Purple Sage Elementary. I can provide morning or afternoon care for school age children that can ride the bus, to Purple Sage Elementary, Grisham Middle School, and Westwood High School. The option of transport to and from school is available for full time clients with a second school age child for before or after school care.

Elementary students can be walked to the bus stop or supervised from the front yard.

Middle and high school children will have to walk themselves to the bus stop.

I will not be responsible for Middle and High School children after they leave my home.

If I have no other children to care for I will wait at the bus stop or keep watch from my front yard.

#1 - \$600 per month or \$800 includes meals.- **One child**, five days a week, for 6 to 8 hours a day, between 6am and 6pm, for four weeks. Flat Rate Between 30 to 40 hours per week.

#2 - \$800 per month or \$1200 includes meals.- **Two children**, five days a week, for 6 to 8 hours a day, between 6am and 6pm, for four weeks. Flat Rate Between 30 to 40 hours per week.

#3 - \$550 per month or \$750 includes meals - **One child**, four days a week, for 6 to 8 hours a day, between 6am and 6pm, for four weeks. Flat rate between 24 to 30 hours per week.

#4 - \$750 per month or \$1100 includes meals - **Two children**, four days a week, for 6 to 8 hours a day, between 6am and 6pm, for four weeks. Flat rate between 24 to 30 hours per week.

#5 - \$500 per month or \$700 including meals - **One child**, three days a week, for 6 to 8 hours a day, between 6am and 6pm, for four weeks. Flat rate between 18 and 24 hours per week.

Daily - \$50 per day - **one child**, for one day, for up to 6 to 8 hours a day, between 6am and 6pm
- \$75 per day - **two children**, for one day, for up to 6 to 8 hours a day, between 6am and 6pm

Hourly - **one child**-First two hours is \$10 then it will be \$5 per half hour or \$10 per hour after that.
- **two children**-First two hours is \$20 then it will be \$5 per half hour or \$10 per hour after that.

Date night - \$5 per hour per child. If you would like us to feed them dinner please include an extra \$5 per child for a home cooked meal, burger, or pizza.

All payments must be made in advance or upon the day service is rendered. Please notify me two weeks prior to vacations. You may pay monthly, weekly, or daily based upon your payment plan and agreement. If you use less than the hours we agree on, then a new contract will be written. If you sign up for a no food plan and I have to begin feeding your child lunches there will be a \$10 extra per day charge for their food costs. If these policies are not followed I have the right to terminate services and find new clients. You may pay with cash or check. I do not accept credit at this time. I will work with full time clients, who stay for one year with tax exemptions. *I have the right to refuse care if payment has not been made prior to services being offered.*

I prefer that you bring your child consistently if you are satisfied with your child's care. I like to provide a close, long term relationships between the children in my care. It provides for a better environment and schedule. Please allow me two weeks notice before withdrawing your child from my care.

Our home is narcotic and drug free. We also do not have firearms. All health supplements are out of reach of young children as well as household tools and chemicals that may be dangerous. The kitchen area will always be gated and off limits. Tall furniture and TV's are anchored to the walls for safety. While your children are in my care for the first week I will be learning your child's behaviors. I will remove anything that may cause a problem or be hazardous.

My promise as a care giver is to provide the best motherly care possible. I will be keeping a very small group environment to ensure that I will not be overwhelmed. This will allow me to provide the best care to each individual. My experience with children has become my profession for the last eight years of my life. I take it very seriously and strive to make every day more efficient than the last. Whether your children are young or school age, I have the skills necessary to keep them safe, healthy, and happy. You may withdraw your children at any time. This contract is not locked. I hope that you are satisfied with the care I provide so you will keep coming back. At any time please express your concerns, comments, or suggestions to me so I may provide the best care for your children.
